WHEREAS, the events and activities of SCMAP provide an opportunity for these members to network, exchange ideas and information to improve their work and processes, and these may involve the disclosure of information that can be competitively sensitive;

WHEREAS, the organization recognizes that these activities and events could provide a venue for the conducting of anti-competitive and unfair business practices, which is against the spirit of community that this organization fosters;

THEREFORE, this organization is adopting and implementing an Anti-Trust Policy, which will apply to all its members, officers and employees;

THEREFORE, this Anti-Trust Policy disallows its members to engage in activities that lead to monopolization, restriction of trade, and other anti-competitive and unfair business practices, in accordance with the provisions of Republic Act No. 10067, otherwise known as the Philippine Competition Law;

THEREFORE, the SCMAP Secretariat, led by its Executive Director, will oversee the implementation of this policy and ensure that its members follow it, and will also receive reports of any anti-competitive behavior undertaken by its members through SCMAP activities and events;

THEREFORE, a copy of the Anti-Trust Policy will be sent to all of SCMAP's members, officers and employees, and must be acknowledged in writing, either online or offline, and will also be made available to the public.
